FIG 1 : POPULATION BY SEX 1930 (T) 1986

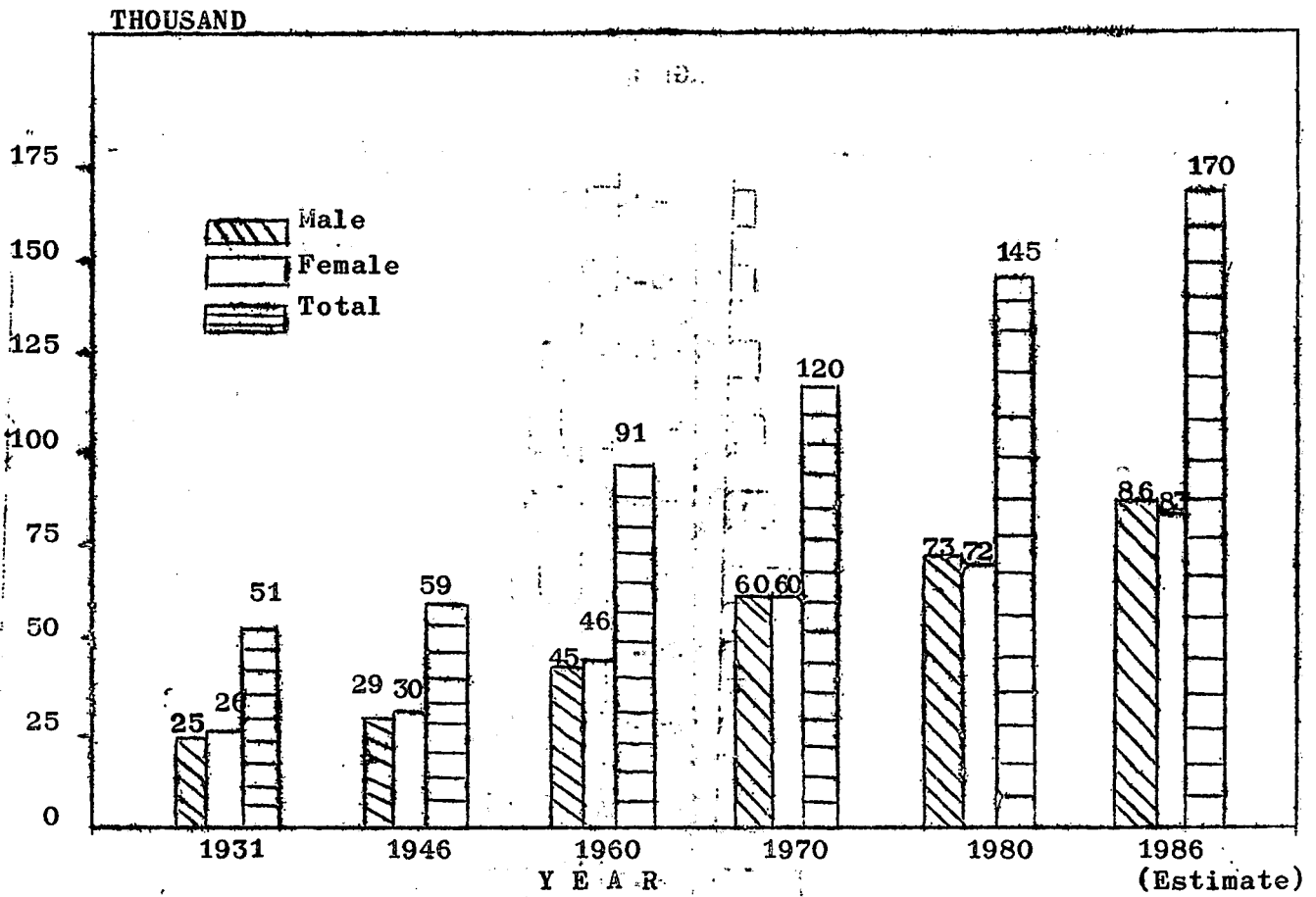


FIG 2 : POPULATION BY DISTRICT 1980 (CENSUS)

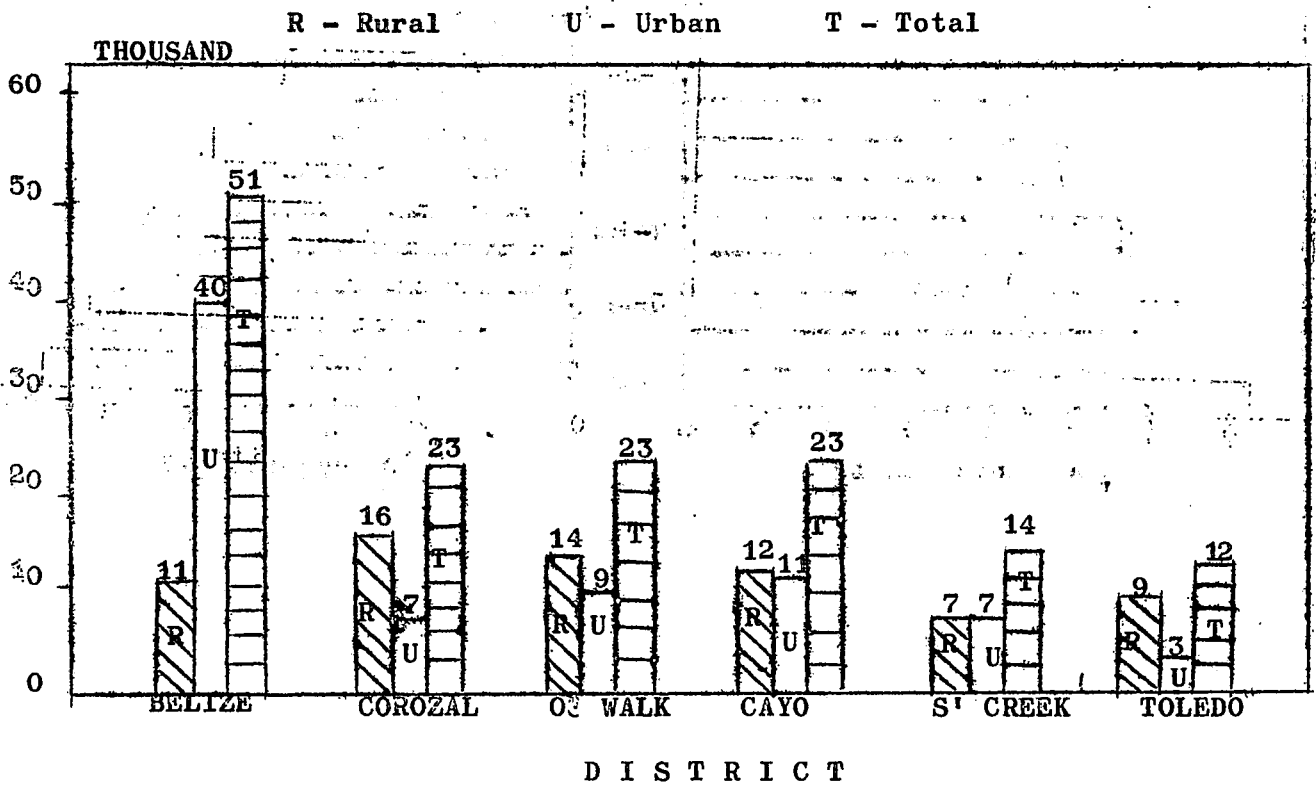


FIG 3: MID-YEAR POPULATION ESTIMATE BY AGE AND SEX - 1986

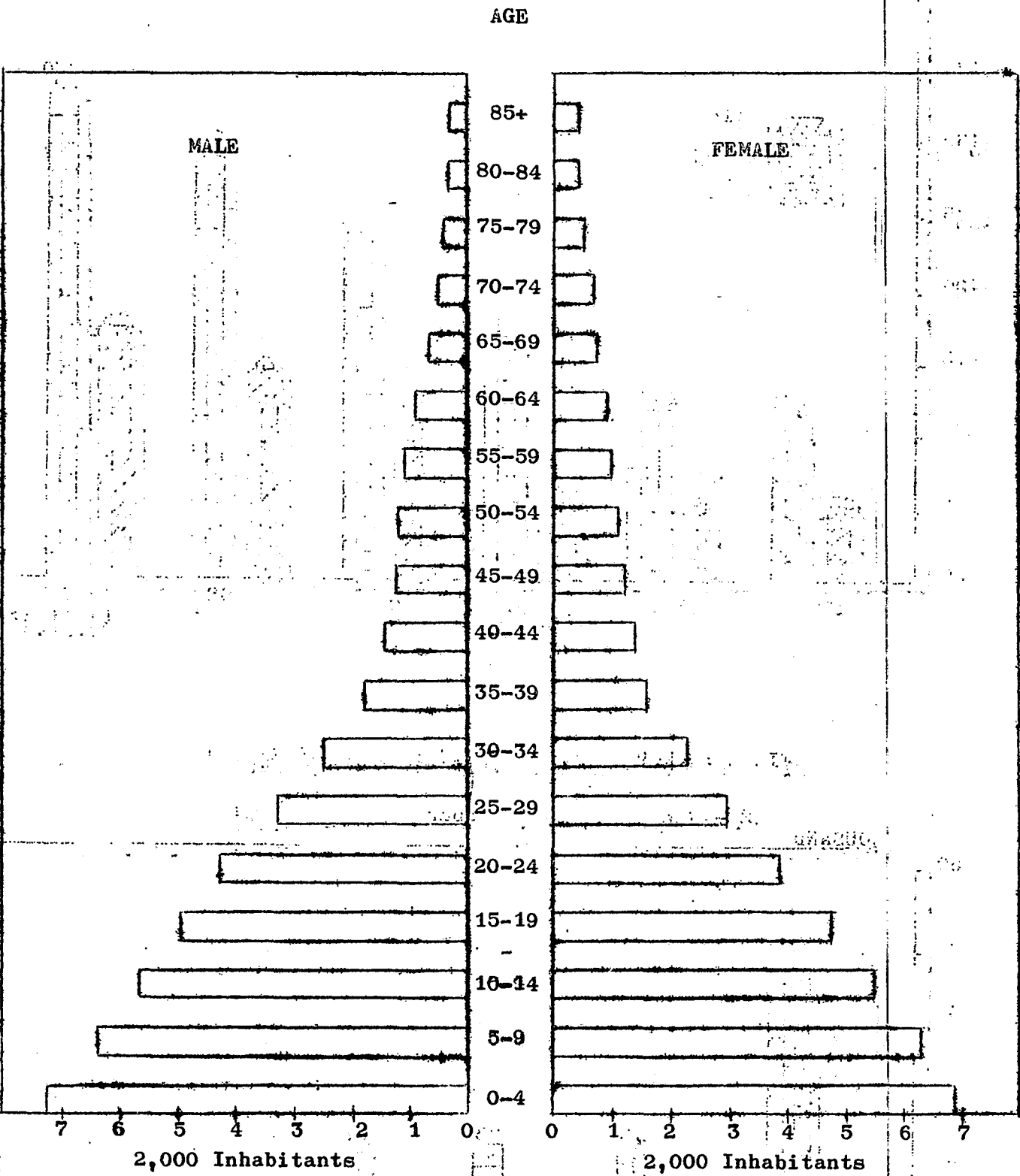

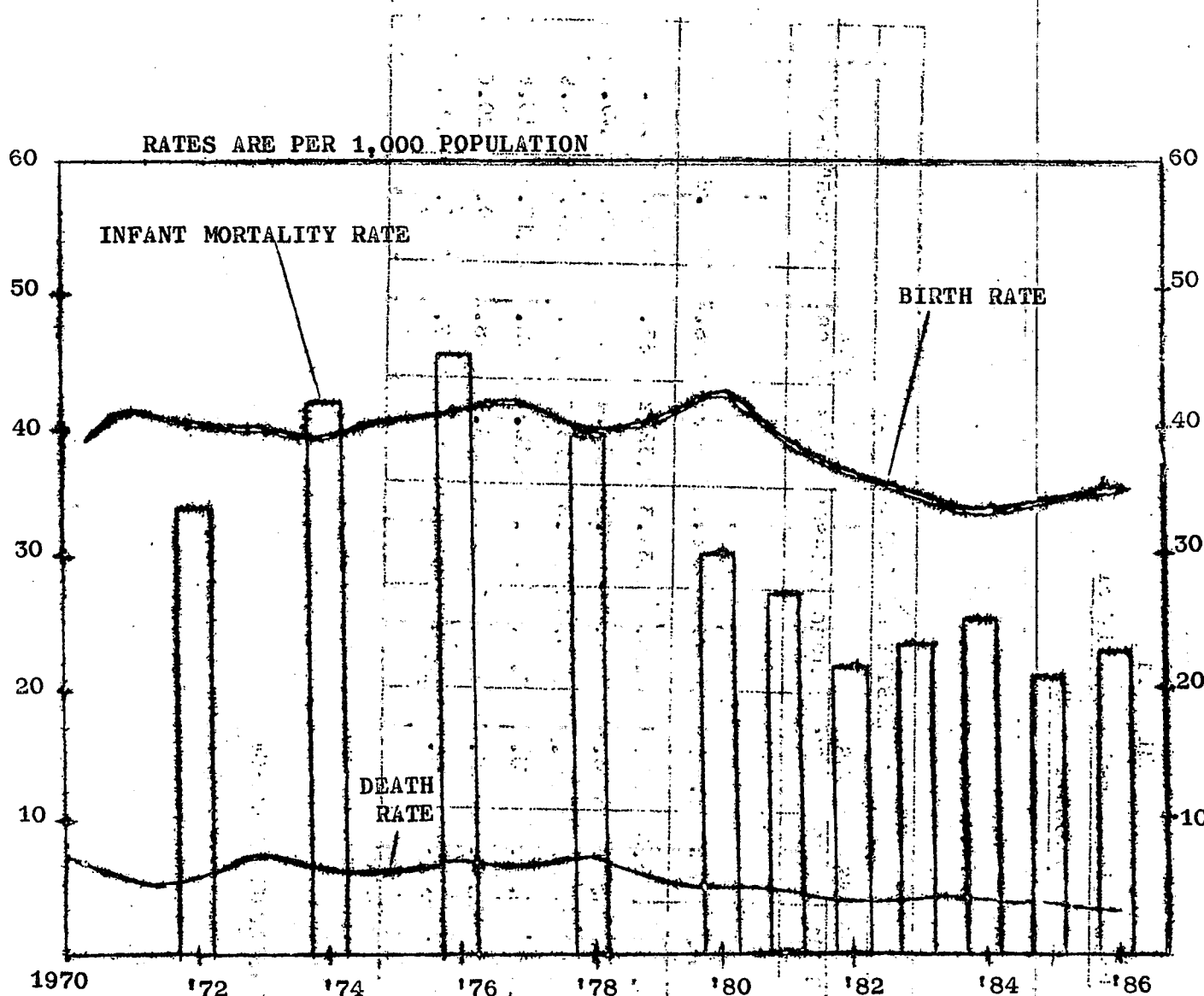

FIG 5. PARTICIPATION IN EDUCATION - 1986

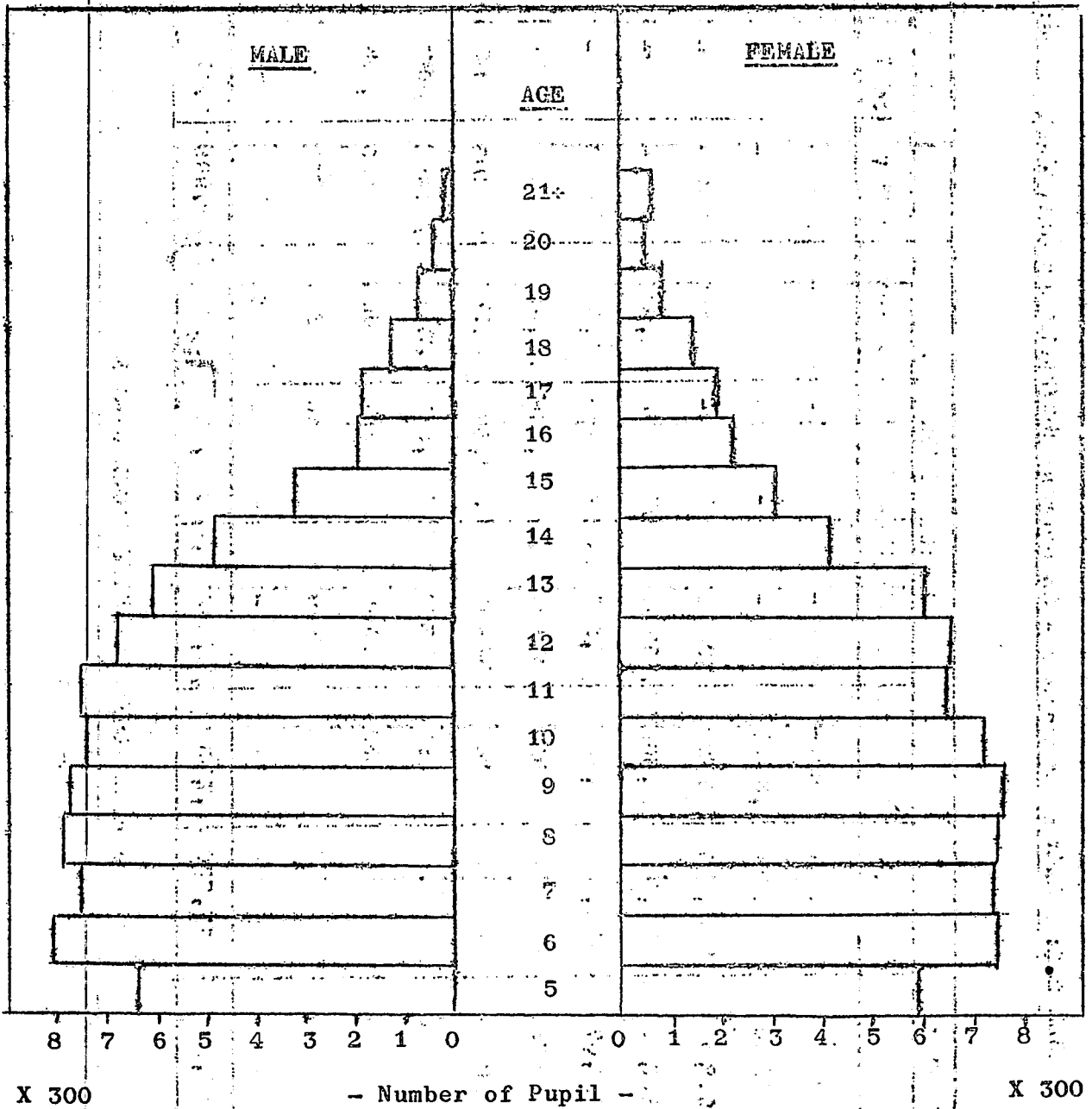
