Suggestions and comments regarding the contents of this publication will be welcomed, and these should be directed to:

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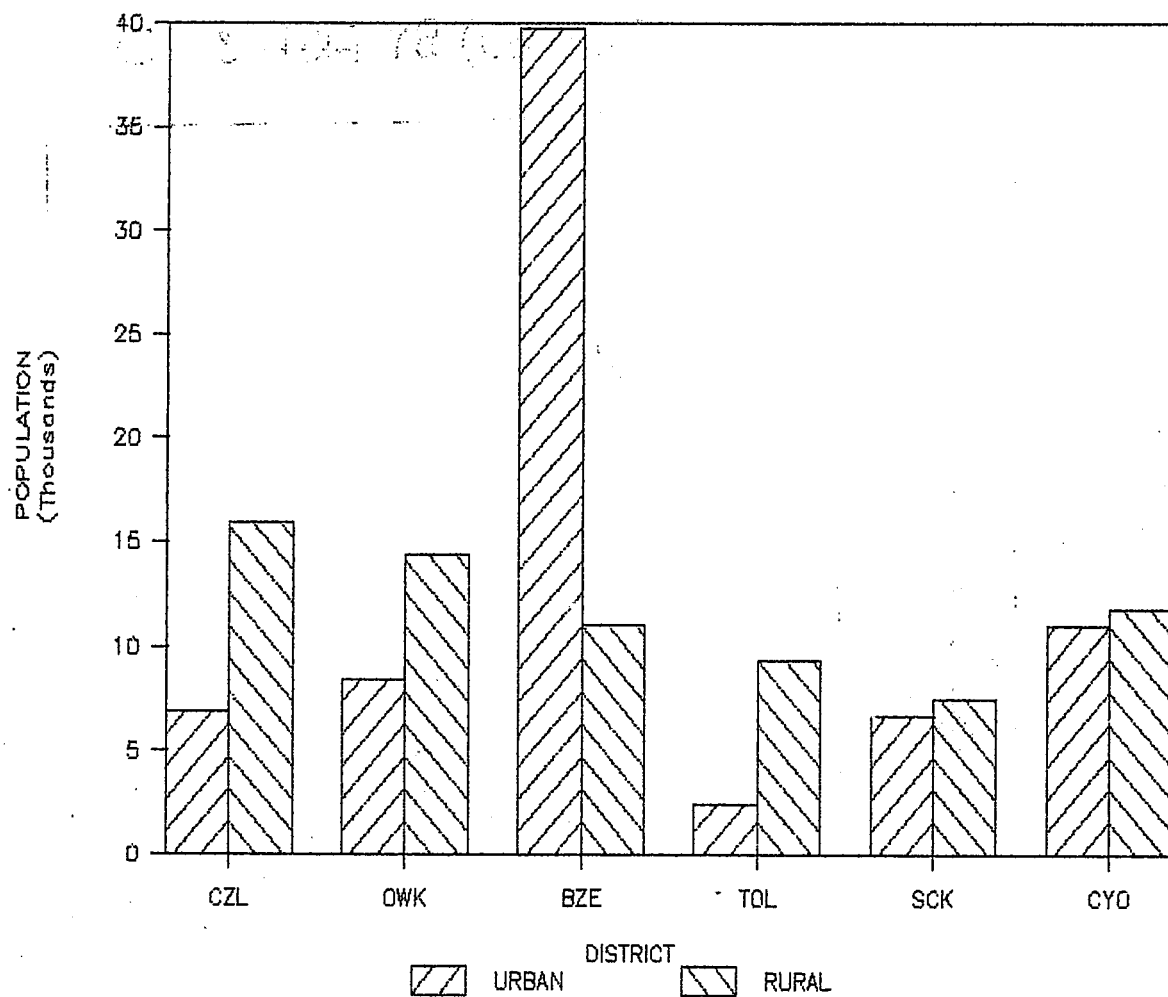
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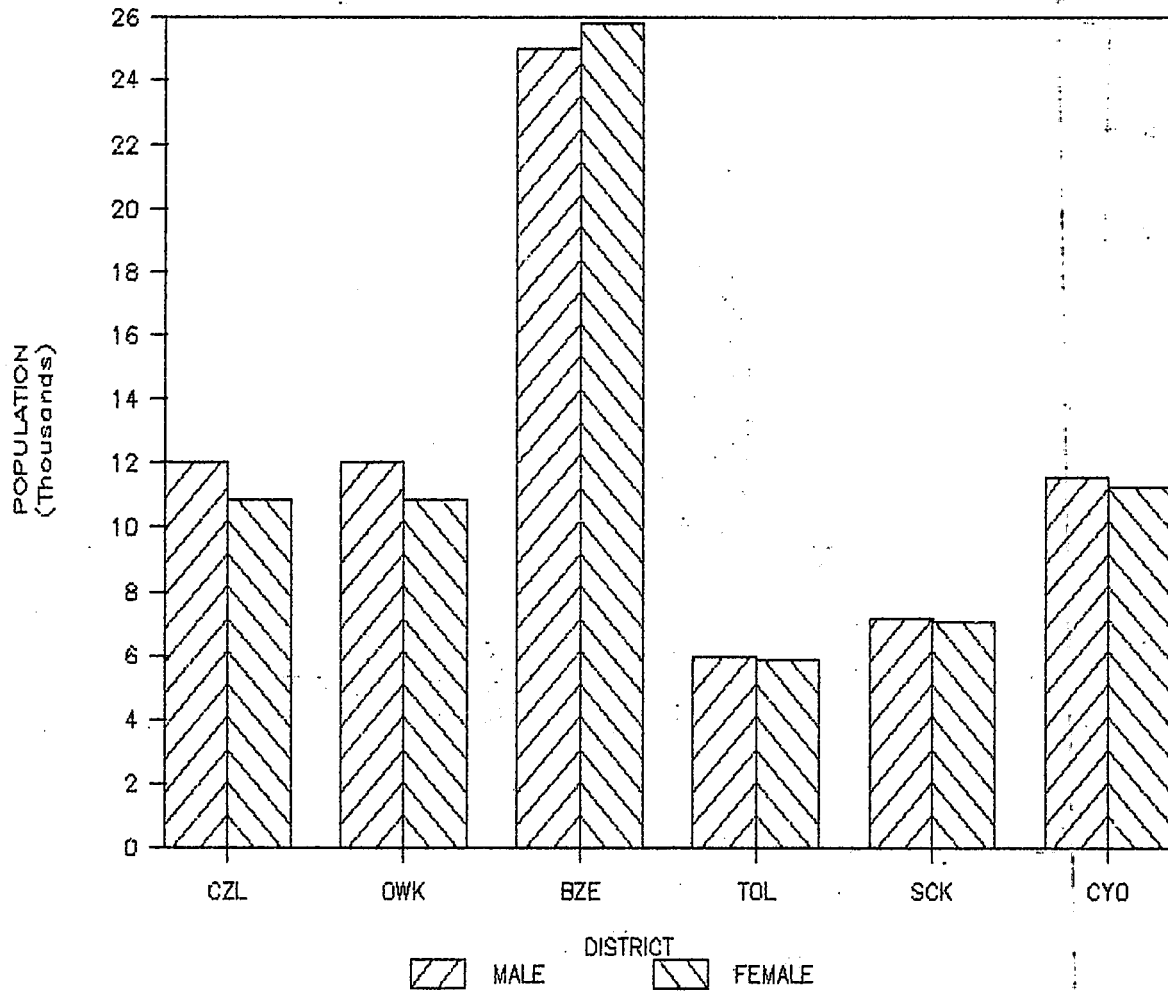

MID-YEAR POPULATION ESTIMATE, 1988

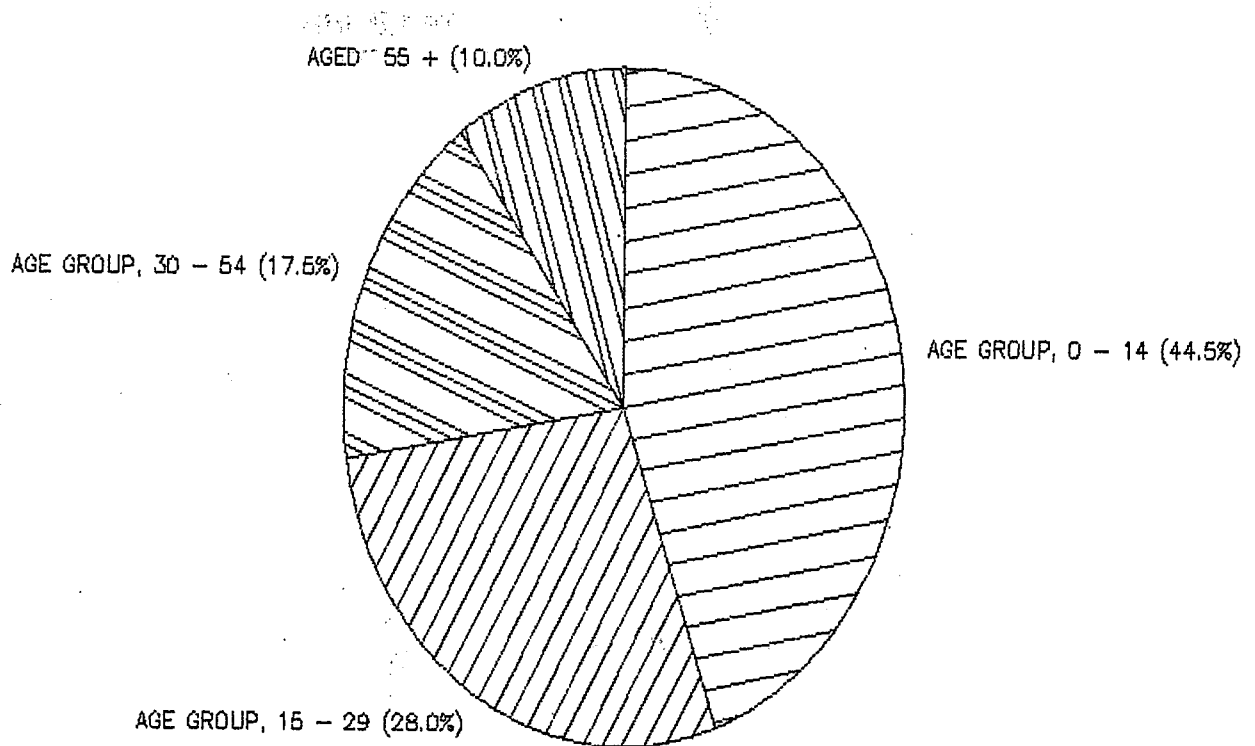

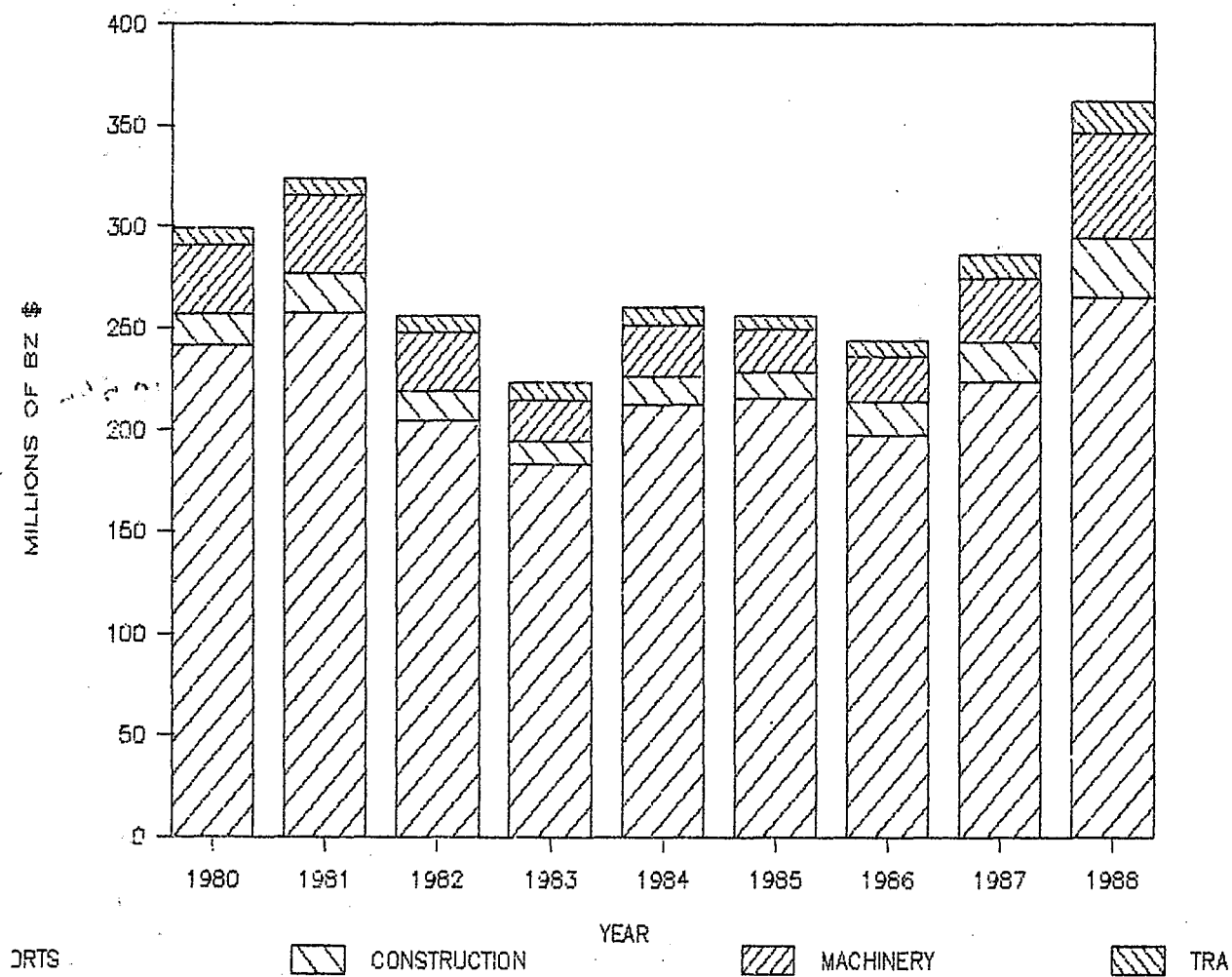

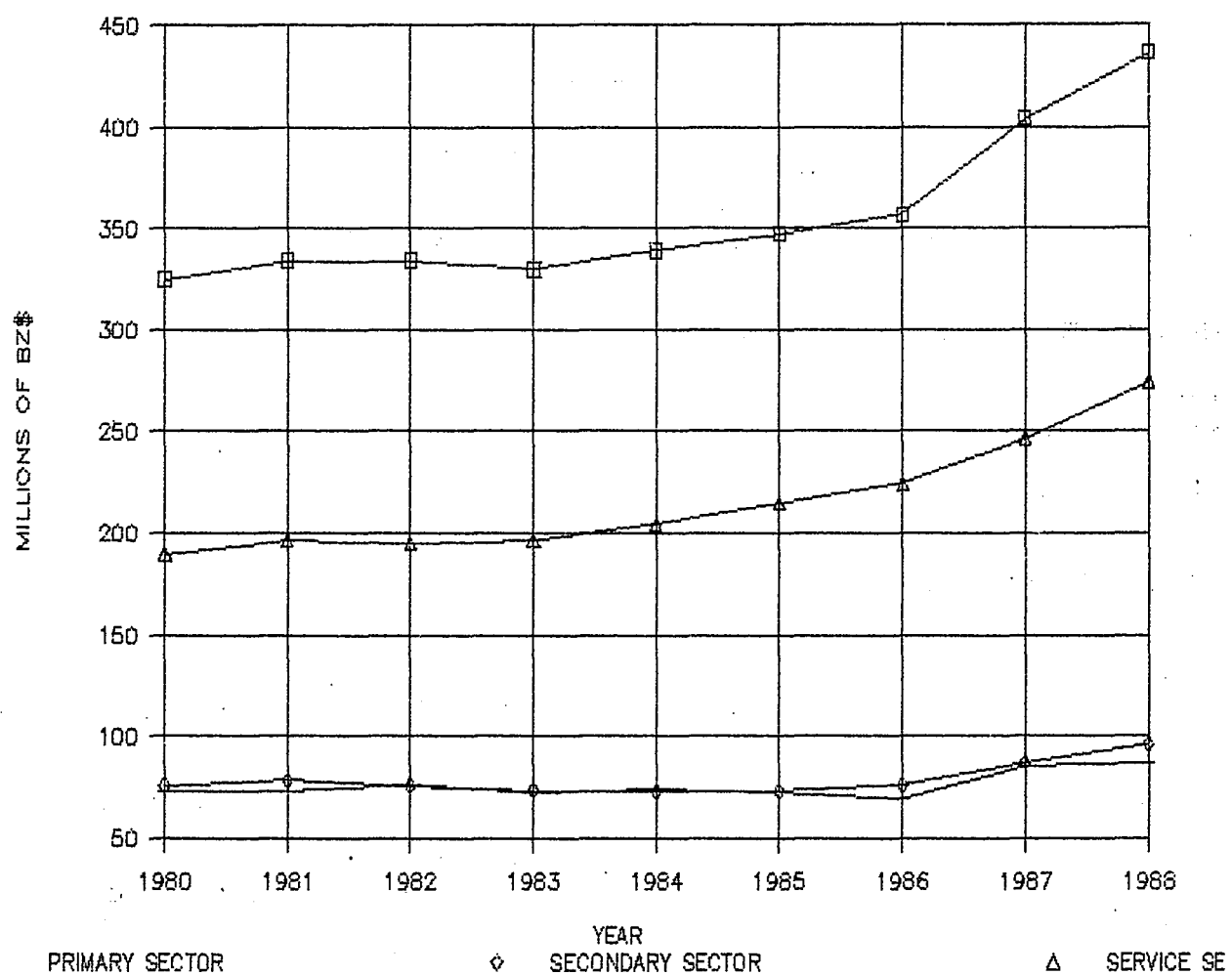
